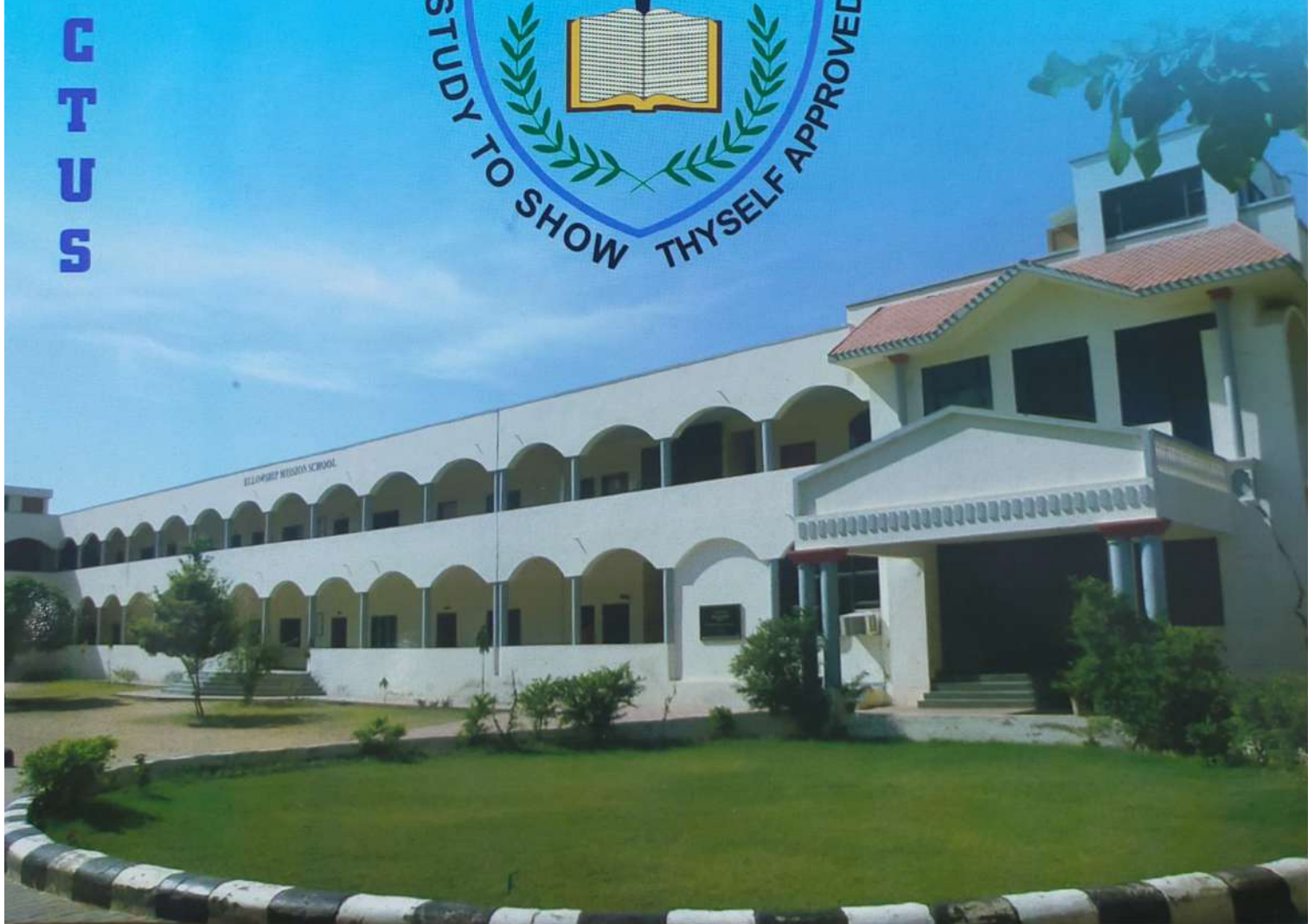

Philosophy of education at Fellowship Mission School

The school is dedicated to provide a challenging environment which is child centered, well balanced and aims to develop the whole child. Our school is a centre of enquiry, creativity and joyful learning with students coming together to learn, to dream and to grow.

In the class room, the teacher functions more in a guiding and supportive role than in the role of dissemination of information. Students learn interpersonal skills and importance of the community. They are valued and accepted and in return learn the value and respect others.

Positive feed back and encouragement are essential components of our school assessment. A theme based curriculum, integrating concepts, skills and talents enable students to pursue in depth, a meaningful learning.

Guidelines To Parents

- The school at all times desires to have your cooperation and close contact with the teacher of your ward in order to create an atmosphere that shall be conducive for the better education of our students. The school diary fulfills this need.
- Your wards should report to school in time, bring all the necessary books according to the timetable and be neatly dressed in full uniform.
- Your prompt attention to the teachers note is very essential for a joint effort to look after the education of your ward. Read the remarks in the diary and duly respond. In case you wish to see the teacher in connection with the progress of your ward, you are requested to contact the school office and fix an appointment before you come to school. Our school will give you necessary information from time to time.
- Collect the report cards personally on the day of the declaration of results. It will not be delivered to the students or through the students. Any discrepancy of marks in the report card should be brought to the notice of the Principal.
- Ensure that no teacher is approached when he/she is in the class. In case of any need, prior appointment may be sought through the school diary.
- Parents must attend parent teachers meeting when called upon, to know the progress of their ward.
- In case of any change in your address and contact number, notify the school office and the class teacher.
- Your wards should not carry any expensive articles to school. In case they are lost the school will not be responsible for the loss.
- Mark all the belongings of your wards including the uniform bags, shoes and pullover with details such as name, class and section.
- Students are not permitted to leave the school premises during the school hours unless it is an emergency, for which the Principal's office should be contacted.
- Immorality, grave insubordinate action, contempt of authority or willful damage to property are also reasons for dismissal.
- Inculcate in the minds of your wards, the habit of respecting teachers, school and the school uniform. They must also learn to give due respect and regard to elders at home and outside.
- Parents are not allowed to interfere with the school administration in any way. In case of any problem, they can discuss the same with the Principal.
- Management shall have the power to modify, amend or add rules as the need arises.
- Visitors are not allowed to go in to the classrooms to talk to teachers or students. In case of any problem, they can discuss the same with the Principal.
- You can meet the Principal in her office on all working days from 9.30 am to 12.30pm.
- We expect you to scrupulously follow the above points for the bright future of your ward.

Broad Objectives

The school ,besides imparting academic education in the commonly accepted courses endeavors:-

- To discover ,define and refine the hidden talents in the child and to provide him or her a career oriented education
- To provide education to the child in Indian environment based on academic literacy and cultural heritage of the country
- To provide obedient loyal, faithful ,true and constructive citizen ,having a staunch nationalistic aptitude with high moral values.
- To impart education, general as well as vocational to all irrespective of religion ,caste ,creed and color in an atmosphere of purity, efficiency, discipline with a special emphasis on character building
- All round development of personality through effecient education by teachers of high caliber and total dedication
- To develop creative potential of children through painting ,music and other form of art.

At the same time the school tries to embody such of the features of the English public school as one suitable to Indian conditions.

Admission

- Admission usually takes place at the beginning of the term in April.
- Admission is granted when a candidate clears the relevant test.
- At the time of admission, it is compulsory to submit the Birth Certificate and Transfer Certificate.
- The Principal reserves the right of admission.
- If a day scholar has to be withdrawn from school, one month notice has to be given in writing, failing which one month's fees will be charged
- Transfer certificate will be issued only after all the dues are paid.

Fees

In the event of default, late fee of Rs.100 per month will be charged. If the fee is not received within 10 days of the expiry of the scheduled date, the student's name may be struck off the rolls and will be readmitted on payment of admission fees of Rs 1000, subject to the approval by the Principal.

Under no circumstances the student will be allowed to appear for the examination, until school fees/dues are paid in full.

Examination/Periodical Test

It is compulsory for every student to appear for all the examination/periodical tests scheduled by the school.

In case of sickness, the parents are to inform the Principal and obtain prior permission for absence. They should also submit a medical certificate.
